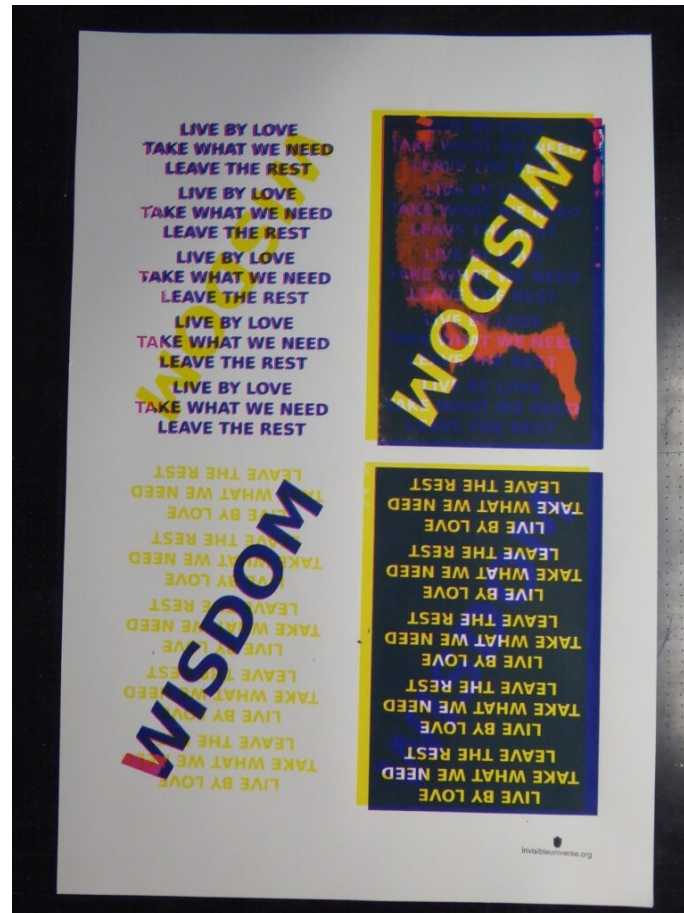
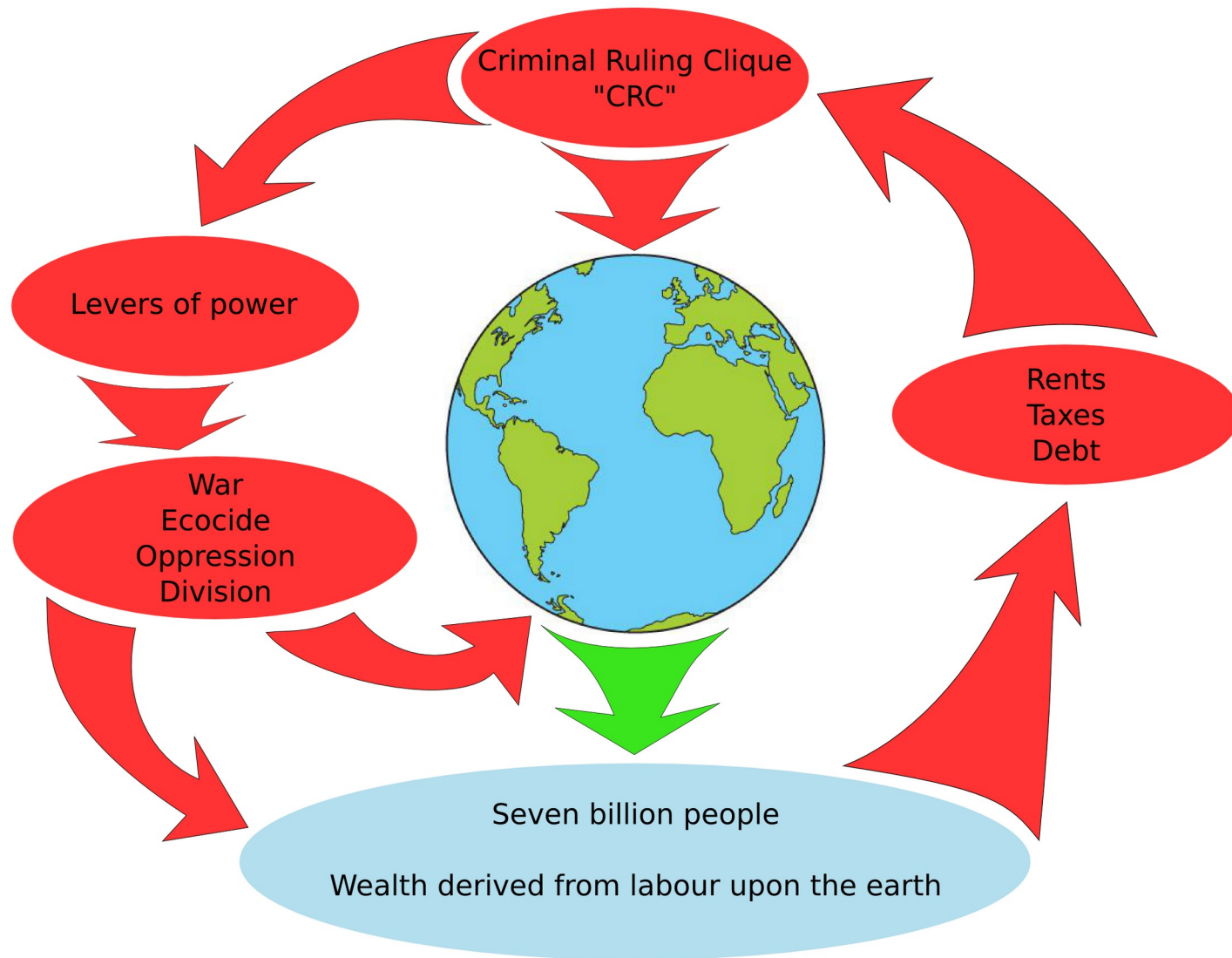

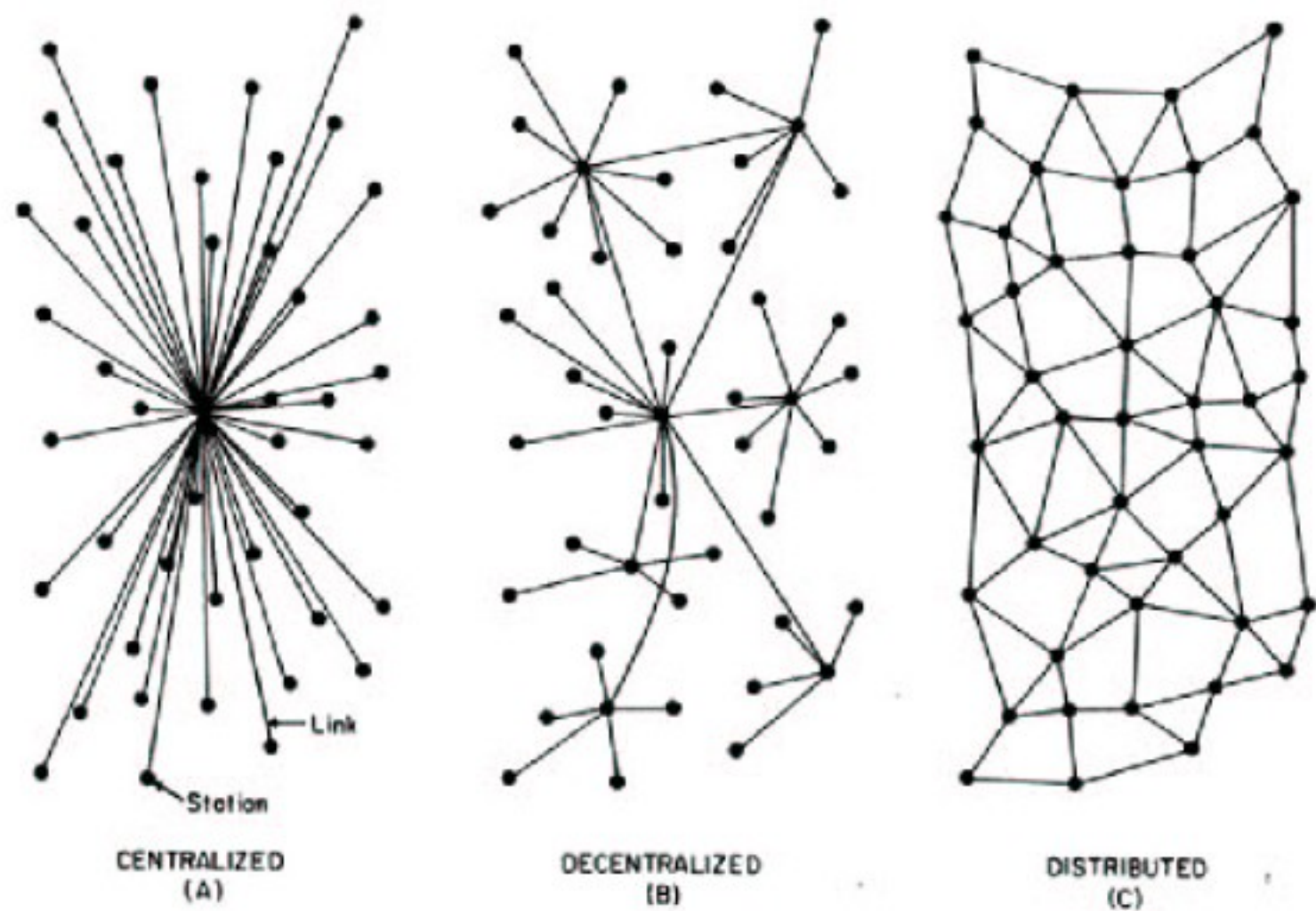


FIG. 1 - Centralized, Decentralized and Distributed Networks

- DACSO – Distributed Autonomous Codependent Self-Organisation



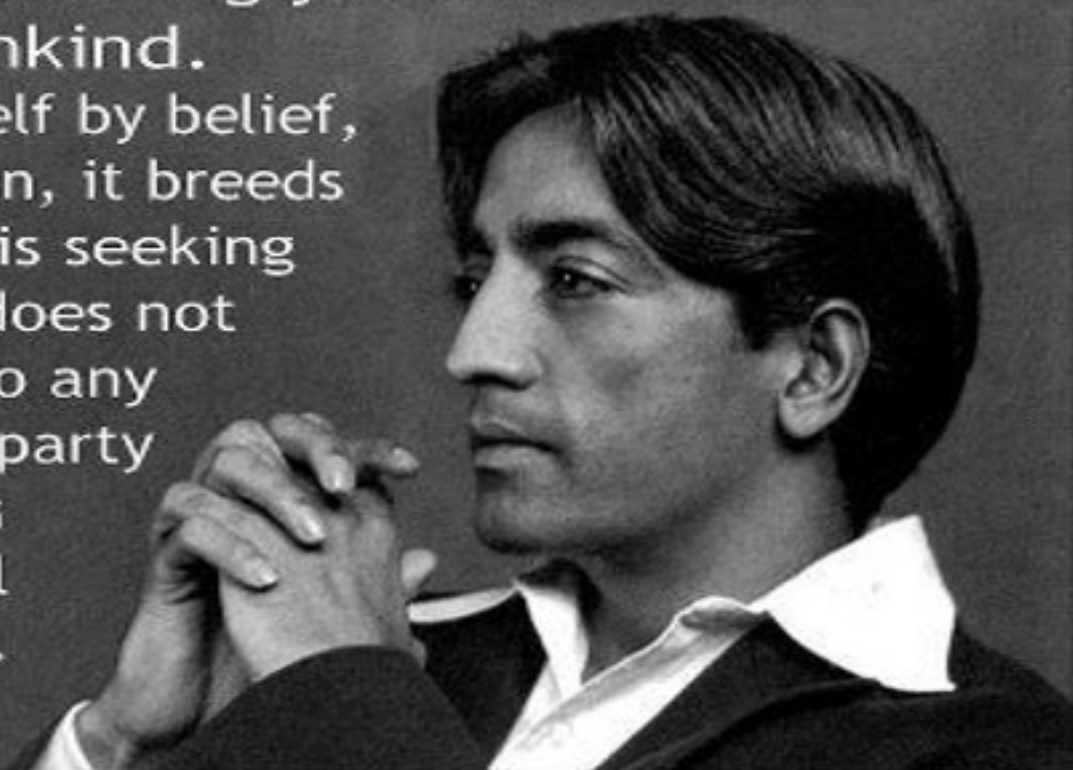
